# Projection Assumptions

- Arrests Projected Based on 1986-1993 Trend
- Rate of Commitments Per "At-Risk" (0-17) Population Continues at 10 Year Trend
- Assumes Juveniles are Held To Age 18 In Juvenile System
- Includes Impact of Measure 11 Increased Commitment Terms (Length of Stay)
- Does Not Include Adjustment For Negotiated Petitions on Measure 11 Crimes

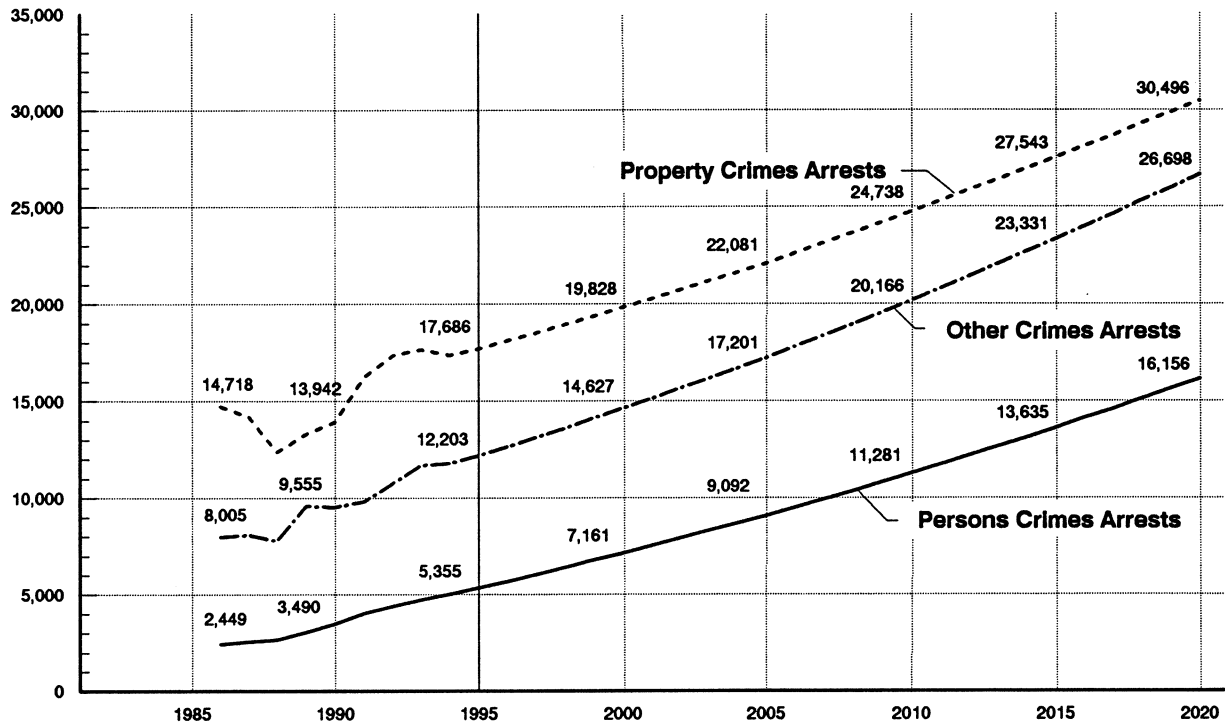

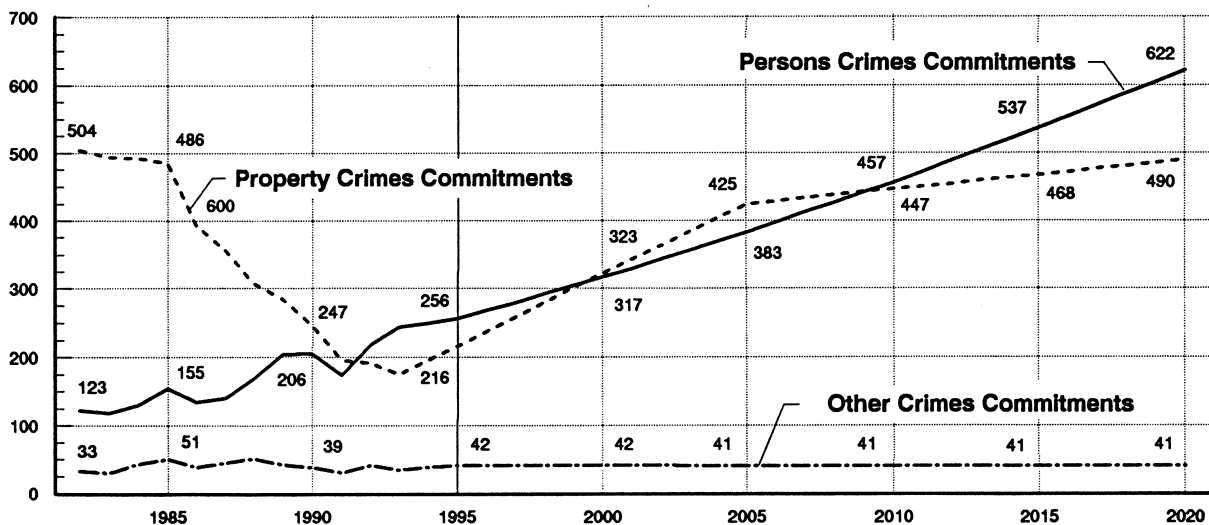

By Crime Type, 1986-2020

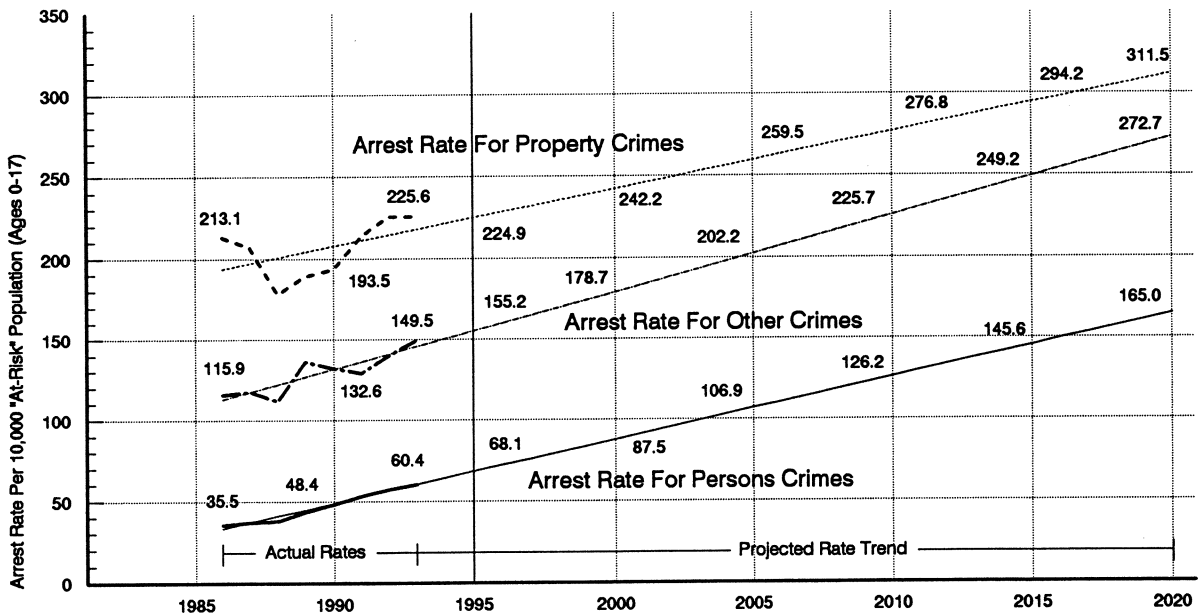


## Juvenile Commitments

By Crime Type, 1982-2020

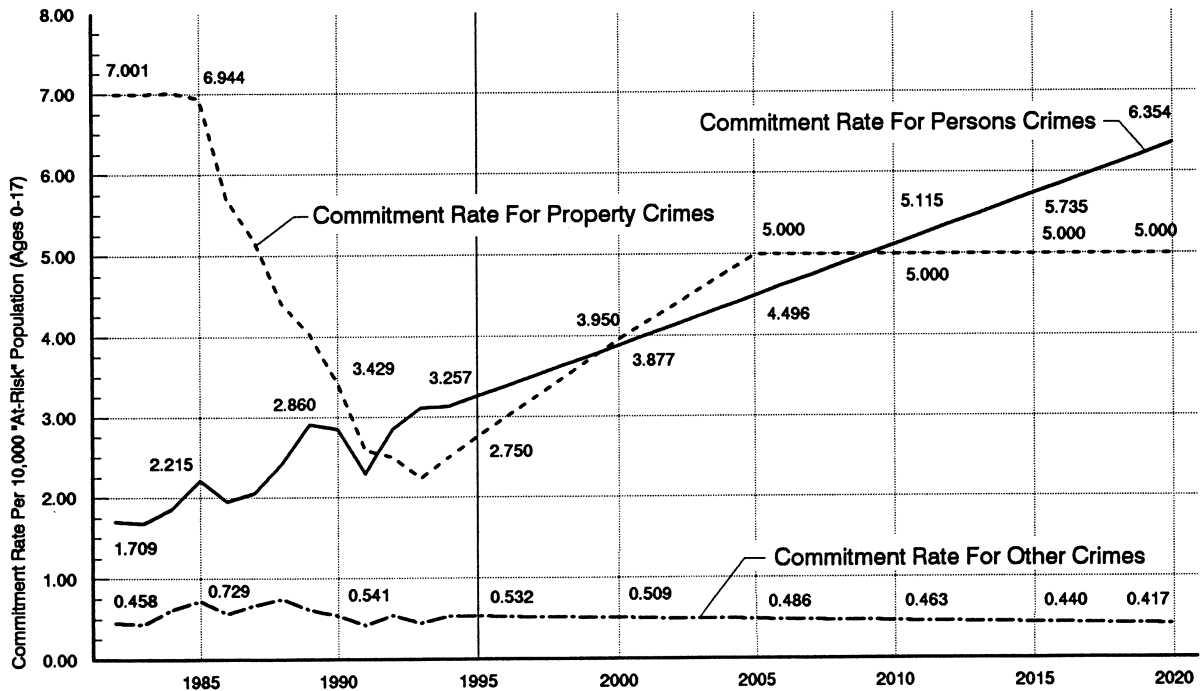


## Arrest Rate Per 10,000 "At-Risk" Population By Crime Type, Population Ages 0-17



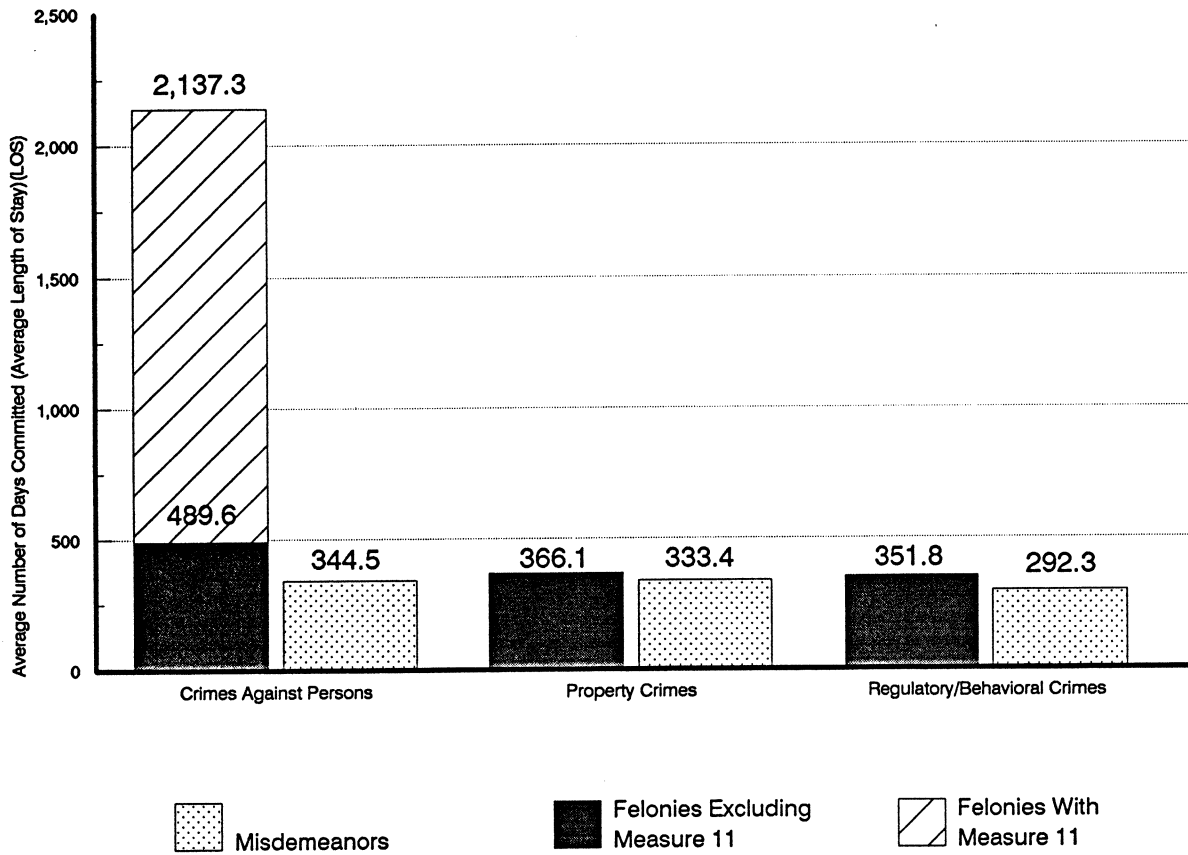

## Commitment Rate Per 10,000 "At-Risk" Population By Crime Type, Population Ages 0-17

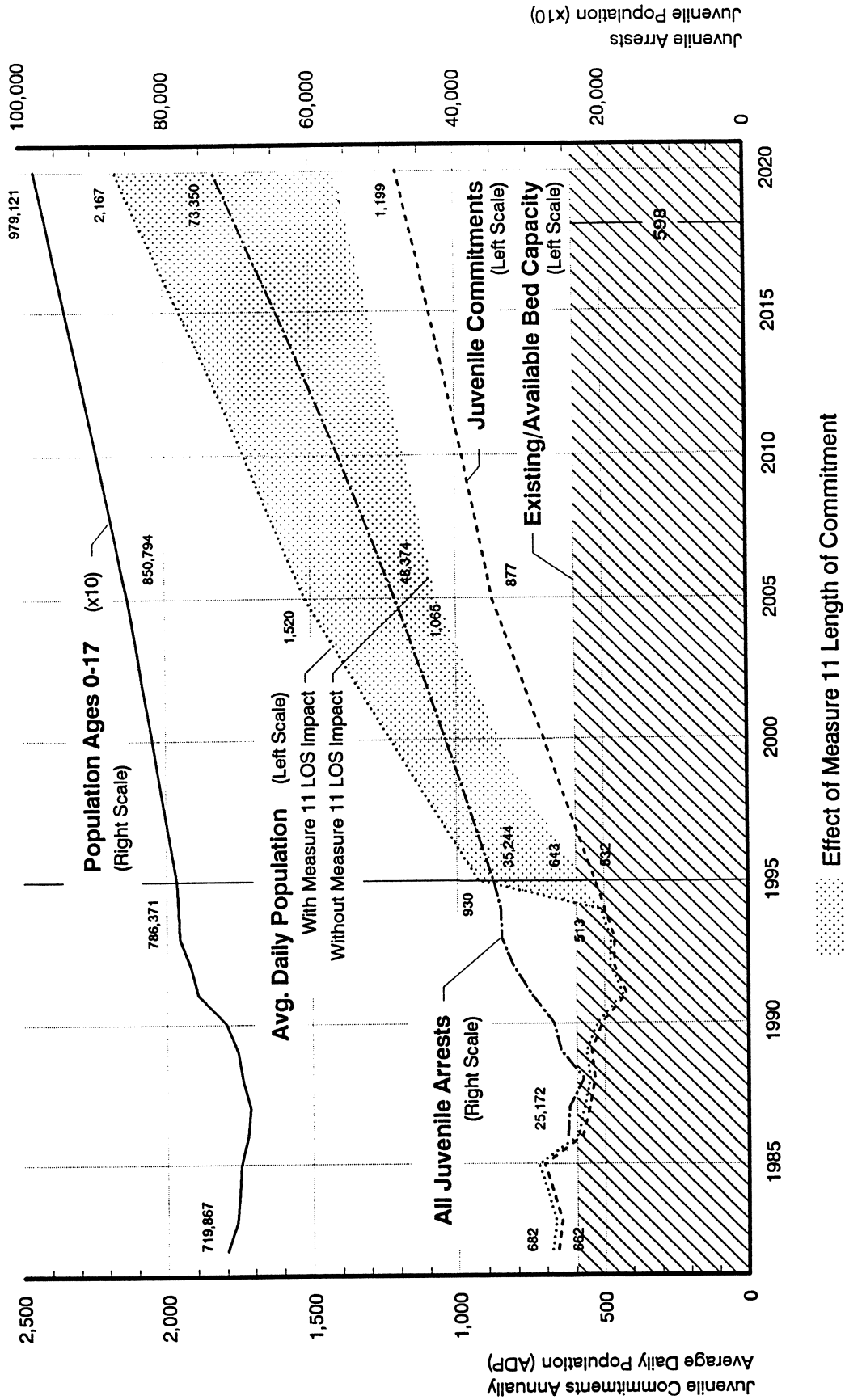


## Average Length of Stay (LOS)

Actual Commitments and With Impact of Measure 11, 1982-1994

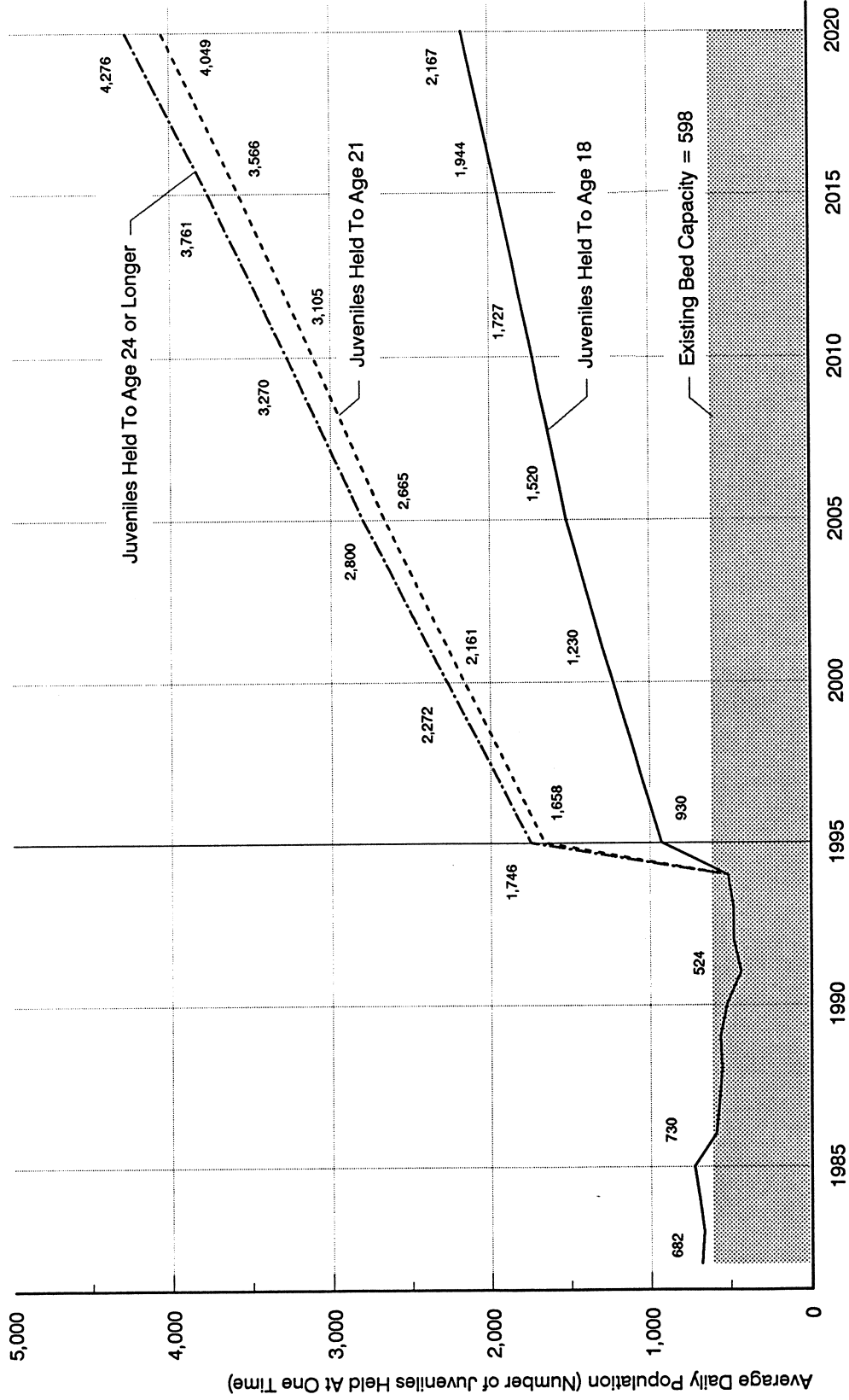


# Juvenile Arrests and Commitments and Juvenile Average Daily Population, 1982-2020
