Dal Ponte becomes acting director of State Department of Aviation
Gregg Dal Ponte is a veteran state manager with a strong record in transportation

Salem—The Oregon Department of Administrative Services (DAS) announced today that Gregg Dal Ponte has assumed the reins of the State Department of Aviation as the agency's acting director.

Dal Ponte is a veteran manager with broad experience and a long history of service in state government. Immediately before stepping in to head the Department of Aviation, he served as administrator of ODOT's Motor Carrier Transport Division, a post he held for 13 years. In that job he was responsible for commercial vehicle registration, size and weight enforcement, highway use tax collection, economic entry and rate regulation, the commercial vehicle safety program, and other important programs.

Before joining ODOT, Dal Ponte has held management positions in the Department of Human Services, beginning in 1991.

DAS has begun preparing the recruitment process for a permanent director of the Department of Aviation, which will kick off soon.
